Liberation Art Gallery CIC provides therapeutic, arts-based alternative education for young people who benefit from a smaller, structured and supportive learning environment.

Our programmes combine creative practice, mentoring and emotional support to help young people re-engage with learning, build confidence and develop positive routines.

We work with schools, SENCOs and local authorities to support learners with a range of needs including:

- Social, Emotional and Mental Health (SEMH) needs
- Autism Spectrum Conditions
- ADHD
- School refusal or reduced timetables
- Young people at risk of NEET

Our Approach

Our provision is:

- Creative and arts-based
- Therapeutic and supportive in nature
- Delivered in small group settings
- Led by experienced creative practitioners and specialist tutors

We focus on engagement, trust-building and progression at a pace suited to the individual learner.

Session Structure

Sessions are delivered across the week in structured AM and PM blocks.

Days of delivery: Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday

Session times:

- Morning: 10:00am – 12:00pm
- Afternoon: 1:00pm – 3:00pm

Young people may attend one or more sessions per week depending on their agreed support plan.

Creative Learning Pathways

We offer structured progression routes through creative and arts-based learning:

- Therapeutic Arts Introduction Programme
- Extended Creative Learning with Bronze Arts Award support
- Intensive Bronze Arts Award pathway
- Silver Arts Award progression programme
- Gold Arts Award advanced creative development

Each pathway supports personal development, engagement and recognised arts-based qualifications where appropriate.

Arts Award Accreditation

We support progression through Arts Award qualifications (Discover to Gold).

These programmes can support:

- Confidence building
- Communication and presentation skills
- Independent creative practice
- Leadership and progression into further education or creative careers

Gold Arts Award also carries UCAS points.

1:1 Therapeutic Support (Optional)

Where appropriate, we can provide additional 1:1 art psychotherapy support delivered by a qualified HCPC registered art therapist.

This offers a safe, confidential space for emotional exploration through creative methods.
