

Liberation Art Gallery Prize Competition

Terms & Conditions

1. Eligibility

- The competition is open to **UK residents aged 18 years or older** at the time of entry.
- Employees of Liberation Art Gallery, their immediate families and anyone professionally connected with the competition are **not eligible** to enter.

2. How to Enter

- Entry requires payment of a £20 fee via the link provided in the confirmation email following submission of the initial entry form.
- Entrants must complete the entry form fully, including answering three skill-based questions.
- Only entries with full payment and complete answers will be accepted.
- **Deadline to Enter:** Tuesday 31st March 2026 6pm

3. Prize

- One winner will be selected to receive a solo exhibition at Liberation Art Gallery's downstairs gallery space in Brighton. In addition, the gallery may choose to nominate a second artist working with ceramics or sculptural media, whose work will be exhibited across our double window frontage and on plinths, offering high-visibility, street-facing exposure.
- The exhibition will cover the downstairs gallery (the main floor).
- The prize includes professional curation, installation and promotion via the gallery's website, mailing list and social media channels.
- An optional opening night event may be organised.
- No cash alternative is available.

4. Judging and Winner Selection

- The winner will be selected at random but will be reviewed by a panel of judges to check they meet requirements.
- Questions are reviewed based on the creativity, originality and completeness of the answers to the skill-based questions.
- The winner will be announced on Monday 13th April 2026 via email and on Liberation Art Gallery's social media channels.

5. Intellectual Property

- By entering, participants confirm that all submitted artworks are original and created by themselves.

- Entrants grant Liberation Art Gallery permission (if chosen) to display the artworks physically and digitally during the exhibition.
- Liberation Art Gallery may use images of the artworks for promotional purposes related to the competition and gallery activities.
- Copyright remains with the artist.

6. Data Protection

- Personal data collected as part of the competition will be processed and stored securely by Liberation Art Gallery for the purpose of administering the competition and promoting the exhibition.
- Data will not be shared with third parties except where necessary for the competition (e.g., payment processing).
- Participants can request deletion of their data by contacting the Liberation Art Gallery.

7. Refunds

- The entry fee of £20 is non-refundable.

8. Liability

- The gallery is not liable for any loss or damage arising from participation in the competition or from the exhibition itself.

9. General

- Liberation Art Gallery reserves the right to amend or cancel the competition at any time without prior notice.
- By entering the competition, participants agree to abide by these Terms & Conditions.
